

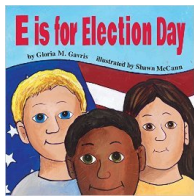
# Needham VOTES 2016

## Schedule of Events

- July 4: March in the **Needham parade** with voting message.
- August–November 8: Air on Needham Channel LWV-Needham **Public Service Announcements (PSAs)** on voting, featuring Needham leaders and citizens.
- September 1: **“VOTE” yard signs** around Needham.
- **September 8: Primary election.**
- **September 20: Special election, Minuteman High School building project**
- October 1: Needham Harvest Fair table with **voter registration and voter information** for November 8 election, including ballot questions and early voting.



- October 4–November 4: **LeagueReads 2016**: League members visit Needham Elementary Schools and read the book *E is for Election Day* and discuss the importance of voting.
- October 1–19: Distribute business-size cards with **voter registration and early voting information.**

- October 1–November 8: Distribute business-size cards with **early voting information.**
- Early October: **Needham High Voter Registration.**
- October 6: **Public Forum** with Nathaniel Stinnett of the Environmental Voter Project. Explore the power of voting.
- October 13: **Guest Column** about ballot questions.
- October: Through [www.lwv-needham.org](http://www.lwv-needham.org) **website** encourage use of VOTE411. Link to ballot question information, secretary of state voting information, town clerk voting information.



- **October 19: Last day to register to vote for November 8th election.**
- October 21: Ballot Question Forum: Focus on 4, Needham Library.
- October 24: Ballot Question Forum: Focus on 2, Broadmeadow School
- October 27 or November 3: **Letter** on the election and voting.
- October 24: **“VOTE” yard signs** around Needham.
- October 24–November 4: **Early Voting** in Needham (see schedule)
- October 24–November 4, November 8: Offer **rides to the polls** for Needham residents.
- **November 8: State and Presidential election.**
