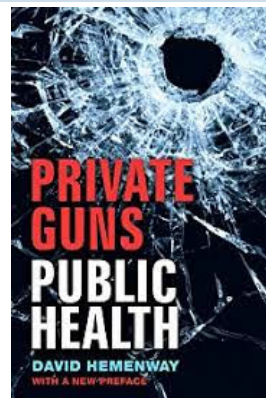


Guest speaker David Hemenway, Ph.D., Professor at the Harvard T.H. Chan School of Public Health is Director of the Harvard Injury Control Research Center. In 2012, he was recognized by the Centers for Disease Control as one of the twenty “most influential injury and violence professionals over the past 20 years.” He has written more than 120 journal articles on gun violence, and authored the book, *Private Guns Public Health*. Dr. Hemenway has received ten Harvard teaching awards.
